## *Teaching*

Jesus taught in the temple and faced criticism from the religious leaders who tried to plot and kill Him.

*Luke 20:20-26*

## *Anointing*

Jesus was anointed with expensive perfume by Mary at Bethany, and Judas offered to hand over Jesus in exchange for money.

*Mark 14:1-11*

## *Last Supper*

Jesus washed his disciples' feet and ate a Passover meal with them, telling them that the bread represented His body broken and the wine was His blood shed for their sins.

*Matthew 26:17-30*

## *Crucifixion*

Jesus was put on trial and sentenced to death by crucifixion. He was treated harshly and nailed to a cross between two criminals, dying after six hours.

*Luke 23:1-49*

## *Burial*

Jesus' body lay in a tomb closely guarded by Romans soldiers, and His body couldn't properly be prepared for burial until after the Sabbath was over.

*Luke 23:55*

## *Resurrection Sunday*

On Sunday morning, women close to Jesus went to His tomb and discovered the rock had been rolled away. An angel appeared to them and announced that Jesus was alive!
